### **CERN Visit – Final Details**

We have arranged a Trip Meeting for **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2019** at **6.00 pm** in the **Lecture Theatre** at **Brooke Weston**. At this meeting, we will give final details of the trip and you will have the opportunity to ask any questions.

### **Key Points**

1. Could you please hand in passport and EHIC\* details to us by **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019**, this could either be done by scanning and emailing to Mr Gilyead from home or being brought to Finance where they will be photocopied. (If details for either or both of these are not available, please let me know when you hope to have them.) \*These are free and are available online.
2. Please arrange for the passport and EHIC to be given in at Finance the week beginning **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September**. We will keep them in the school safe until the trip. (If this is not convenient, please notify Mr Pape).
3. Departure will be **7.30 am** on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October** from Brooke Weston. We will return on **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2018** at approximately midnight.
4. Please can you fill in the attached forms and return to school by **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> August**. A copy of these will be taken on the trip and a copy kept in school. Please be assured that these will be securely disposed of after the trip.
5. What to bring:
  - Swiss Francs to purchase your lunch at the CERN café on Wednesday, and all your meals on Thursday apart from breakfast, plus any other spending money.
  - Change of clothes
  - Warm outdoor clothes
  - Comfortable shoes (there will be quite a lot of walking at CERN)
  - Passport and EHIC which will be taken from the school safe and passed to the students at Gatwick Airport.
6. Students are representing Brooke Weston Academy and, as such, we expect respectful behaviour at all times. During the visit, students are not allowed to purchase or consume alcohol or tobacco. When we return to the Hostel in the evenings, students are expected to remain within the Hostel.

## 9. Travel regulations

### **Travel Regulations - (1) Baggage size.**

We are not planning to check in any luggage. It will all go with us in the cabin. Please see the regulations from Easyjet below. You can bring ONE piece of cabin baggage with maximum dimensions of 56 x 45 x 25 cm including handles and wheels. All handbags/carrier bags must be placed inside your one piece of cabin baggage.

### **Travel Regulations - (2) Liquids**

**Liquids in hand baggage** are subject to the following government-imposed restrictions:

The liquid is in a container with a maximum volume of 100ml

All liquid containers meeting the maximum volume of 100ml can be fitted comfortably into a transparent, re-sealable 1 litre plastic bag, measuring 20cmx20cm.

The plastic bag should be presented separately at security

**You will be required to dispose of liquids which do not meet the above requirements at airport security stations.**
