The aim of the course is to successfully take on an organised triathlon arranged by **Just Racing UK** in **Corby** in **2019**. As part of the preparation for this physical challenge, it is felt that students would benefit from accessing a variety of specific training venues, these being East Carlton Park, Corby International Pool, Pitsford Reservoir and the gym facilities at Lodge Park.
